STANDING ORDER

In addition to any other Orders which may have been entered herein, the parties are hereby ORDERED as follows:


Each party, within forty-five (45) days of service on the original Defendant, shall complete the Seminar for Divorcing Parents conducted by Floyd Superior Court. Failure to complete the Seminar in a timely manner shall subject the party to contempt or such other sanctions as the Court shall deem just.

NOTICE: DEFENDANT/RESPONDENT SHALL IMMEDIATELY PAY THE REQUIRED REGISTRATION FEE TO THE FLOYD SUPERIOR COURT RECEIVER'S OFFICE AND SHALL FILE EVIDENCE OF SUCH PAYMENT, AS WELL AS REGISTER FOR THE SEMINAR, WITH THE CLERK OF SUPERIOR COURT OF FLOYD COUNTY.

The Clerk shall attach a copy of this Order to the Petition and all service copies of divorce and separate maintenance actions (not to include URESA, CSRA, Domestic Violence and Contempt actions) in which custody of a minor child is involved.

This Order supersedes any previous Order and is effective as of the date shown below.
