This Standing Order is promulgated pursuant to OCGA §15-23-10, as permitted by Uniform Superior Court Rule 1.2.



2. This Order applies to all parties in all civil cases, including all domestic relations actions defined by Uniform Superior Court Rule 24.1, now pending and hereafter filed, except as set forth in Rule 3 of the Mediation Rules

3. All parties are hereby referred to mediation pursuant to the Mediation Rules and shall comply with the provisions thereof.

4. All parties are directed to mediate and negotiate in good faith.






